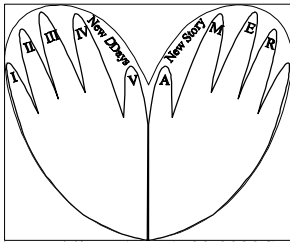

With Republican Age [1700-2000CE] we get civil citizen culture-civilRepublican 'homelife' ['human heritage in cultural democracy']. AMERI Ages is civilRepublican 'we the people' creating our country family, our public home, in chosen representatives and universal principles written into common law from natural law, affirming in ceremonial civility, and living in civil principles daily. Democracy is difficult to attain-live-amend. Military Sparta defeats democratic Athens. Citizens' Roman Republic changes to caesars' Roman Empire, then to clergy's Holy Roman [ Bible/ Constantine-Frankish-Hapsburg theocracies]. Corporate royal interests and holy clergy agendas dominate political parties in contemporary democracies. Republican Age civil society often turn to one-party state or military dictatorship in coup/ civil war, end free press and civil liberties, stop free election and representative government, arrest political opponents, or disrespect citizen constitution.

Democracy rests on idea that people are able to govern themselves. Naturally, people dislike dictators and want government concerned with their needs and interests. Most citizen people want peace-prosperity-progress rather than war-war-war that makes banker/corporate director wealthy, clergy less ecumenical, and people poor-poor-poor. Literate citizens do human freedom in liberty/ democracy. Democracy is literate integrity people-rule/ equality people economy. Liberty is fraternity human rights/ 'independency' from powers violent and superstitious. Most valued treasures are freedom charters: independence-constitution-human rights. Political maturity/ social cohesion expand CivilRepublican homelife.

With English nation [Magna Carta 15 Jun 1215, 'Rights of Englishmen'], French nation [Rights of Man, 27 Aug 1789 & Montesquieu's The Spirit of Laws 1748], and U.S. country [Jefferson's Declaration of Independence ,4 Jul 1776; Madison's Constitution 17 Sep 1787 & Bill of Rights 15 Dec 1791; Lincoln's Gettysburg Address 19 Nov 1863 we read 3 Jul], global countries become new republics inspired by the above seven human freedom charters. Many vacillate between democracy/dictatorship. Following WWII, democracy nation-states are encouraged in Japan/ Germany. 1950s-1960s see native African continentals shed colonialism for Americanism in independent self-governing democracy countries or stated nations. Working hard to have new republican systems suitable to varying traditions/situations, citizen people realize over generations that eternal vigilance is price of the natural rights human freedom civil society. History shows citizen people need decent standard of living- democratic traditions- literacy- political maturity. Mr. Madison's preamble models... 'Civil Homelife' ...for US all in cultural democracy:

fraternity:	“We, the people of _[say your democracy country]_, in Order to form a more perfect Union,
integrity:	establish Justice,
liberty:	insure domestic Tranquility,
equality:	provide for the common defense
liberty:	promote the General Welfare, and secure the Blessings of LIBERTY
integrity:	to ourselves and our Posterity,
fraternity:	do ordain and establish this Constitution for the _[say your democracy country]_.”
